ECAC Leadership Training

• The last ECAC Leadership training for the current Chair, Vice-Chair and At-Large members will be on Friday, September 28, 2018. The training topic will be L.A. Care Business Part 2. This training is mandatory for all Chairs, Vice-Chairs and At-Large Members.

T-Shirts for CAC Members

• Manny Vizcarra, *Liaison*, announced that t-shirts would be passed out after the meeting to CAC members. For those who do not have shirts, another order will be made in September.

<u>At-Large Elections</u>

- The ECAC At-Large elections will occur during the November 14, 2018 ECAC meeting.
- There are two ECAC At-Large member positions. One represents the RCACs and the other represents the CCI Councils.
- RCAC members interested in running for the position will need to complete an application, attend the November ECAC meeting, and speak to the ECAC members on why they are the best candidate for the position.
- Ms. Chung reviewed the roles and responsibilities of the At-Large Member positions. The materials are also included in the meeting packets.
- Members who are interested in running for the positions should notify their CO&E staff to receive an application.

- Arun Tes Yang shared that her friend had a good experience with L.A. Care. Her friend needed help in getting transportation to Long Beach Memorial Hospital and L.A. Care was able to assist her.
- Sambour Lay needs assistance with after care for his liver surgery. He was referred to the Jose Mendez, *Member Navigator*, to assist with his case.
- Vandy Chin shared that she is having problems after she got her eyes dilated. She was also referred to Jose Mendez for her issue.

1. Health Education Training Evaluation

- Ms. Chung provided results from the pre and post tests from the three health education trainings.
- Heart Health Pre Test (70%)
 - Post Test (31%)
- Cervical Cancer Pre Test (47%)
 - Post Test (58%)
- Diabetes Pre Test (52%)
 - Post Test (68%)
- Members were asked to fill out an evaluation form for the trainings. This will help CO&E improve future trainings.

2. How to Outreach

- Ms. Chung observed that during outreach events, members needed more practice on how to outreach at events. She reviewed the following points with members to ensure that everyone was providing the same information:
 - Members will receive one reminder call before a scheduled event. It is the member's responsibility to call the staff and notify them of their attendance. If staff is not contacted, the member's attendance will be marked as unexcused.
 - Immediately after arriving at an event, members should first sign the sign in sheet so that they will receive credit for their participation.
 - Members should first introduce themselves as a RCAC member and explain what type of information is available at the outreach event (example diabetes, cervical cancer and heart disease).
 - Tally Sheets should be marked by the member, not the Public. Members were reminded to write their names, RCAC # and the event on the Tally Sheets.
