Approval of Agenda & Meeting Summary

Executive Community Advisory Committee (ECAC) and Board of Governors (BOG) Meeting Update

• There was no ECAC Report to review for the month of August.

Guadalupe Reynoso, **RCAC 5 member**, attended the ECAC meeting on July 10, 2019 and provided the following report:

- o A program called the *Health Homes Program* was launched in July that will identify people with multiple chronic conditions and deficiencies in activities of daily living; this program will last for 30 months.
- As of January 1st, 2020 state subsidies will be added to those individuals in Covered California, and makes the program more affordable for Californians to purchase coverage with Covered California.
- An *Individual Mandate* will take effect as of January 1st, 2020 establishing a state requirement that people must have health coverage. The financial penalty for not having coverage would be the same as the federal mandate (\$695 per adult/\$2,085 per family).

Deysi Corona, RCAC 5 member. attended the BOG meeting on July 25, 2019 and reported the following:

- o Pretty Thanki, *Local Government Advisor* stated that through the *Medi-Cal Expansion*, effective January 1st, 2020 undocumented individuals from age 19 through age 25 who meet all other eligibility criteria, can apply in full-scope Medi-Cal.
- Changes have taken effect to the CalFresh program benefiting older adults and people with disabilities receiving supplemental security income (SSI).

• Eight new medical students have been identified that will be receiving fully paid medical school scholarships through L.A. Care's *Elevating the Safety Net Initiative*.

CO&E Report

American Red Cross Presentation - Archibald Cattarusa-Bernard

- Members' received a presentation on how to prepare for a disaster, and basic information that will help them respond appropriately in an earthquake, fire, or other natural disaster.
- All members received information on the importance of creating a disaster kit, making a plan before a disaster occurs, being informed and learning about the disasters that could happen in the area they live in & finding out about local resources, preparing for a disaster & what to do before, during and after a natural disaster.
- The presentation also included info for individuals with access & functional needs, seniors, people with pets and additional resources & a Be Red Cross Ready checklist to help people prepare to be ready in case of an emergency.
