- Maria Montes informed that Board of Governors had an all-day retreat, ECAC in the month of September.
- Mrs. Montes informed Mrs. Baackes gave information about public charge and how this will affect residents and citizens.
- Mrs. Montes informed that L.A. Care will be having a disaster preparedness training.
- Mrs. Montes informed that L.A. Care is in the process of finding a place to open a new L.A. Care Community Resource Center in the city of Long Beach, she also informed that the L.A. Care Community Resource Center in the city of Pomona will be opening soon. The resource centers will be 50% bigger.

<u>Dorothy Lowery, RCAC 8 member</u>, attended the BOG meeting on September 5th and reported the following:

- Mrs. Montes informed that it was very important to fill out and mail back L.A. Care surveys, this will help with documenting members input.
- Mrs. Lowery informed that L.A. Care gave 19 grants for new doctors, through the Elevating the Safety Net Funding.
- Mrs. Lowery informed that L.A. Care employed 58 new doctors, this will help see 100,000 more patients.
- Mrs. Lowery informed that there was a special training for 3,000 home care providers, to be able to visit additional homes.
