The governor signed SB 1100 in August 2022, and a short section was added to the Brown Act as the governor. Code Section **54957.95** to supplement language already part of the Brown Act:

(a) In addition to authority exercised under Sections 54954.3 and 54957.9, the presiding member of the legislative body conducting a meeting may remove an individual for disrupting the meeting.

(b) As used in this section, “disrupting” means engaging in behavior during a meeting of a legislative body that actually disrupts, disturbs, impedes, or renders infeasible the orderly conduct of the meeting and includes, but is not limited to, both of the following:

(1) A failure to comply with reasonable and lawful regulations adopted by a legislative body under Section 54954.3 or 54957.9 or any other law.

(2) Engaging in behavior that includes using force or true threats of force.

(54954.3 contains provisions related to public comment time restrictions, and 54957.9 allows the presider to clear the room if the meeting can’t continue.)
